Paul TAPPONNIER

Prof. Paul Tapponnier, who now heads the Tectonics/Earthquake research group at the Earth Observatory of Singapore, NTU, is one of the foremost scientist of his generation in the field of neotectonics. His research interests include continental dynamics and tectonics, particularly in Asia and the Mediterranean; active faulting and seismotectonics; earthquake hazard assessment; quantitative geomorphology; rates of active deformation processes; and rock mechanics and rock deformation physics. He is a member of both the French and USA National Academy of Sciences, a fellow of the American Geophysical Union, Geological Society of America, and Geological Society of London.
