Tim Byrne

Prof. Tim Byrne is an associate professor of Geosciences and Co-Director of the Environmental Sciences Program at the University of Connecticut, USA. He is a GSA Fellow, a Fulbright Fellow and a past recipient of a Shell Oil Faculty Fellowship. He received his PhD from the Univ. of California, Santa Cruz. His research focuses on the geologic development of convergent plate boundaries and accretionary prisms and has included field studies of rocks ranging in age from the Precambrian to the Recent. He has also leveraged his experience in studying rock outcrops to better understand active margins that are only observable remotely or through the drilling (e.g., ODP and IODP). He is the author or co-author of over 60 journal articles and books on convergent margins.
