Visit Aso Volcano Museum (60 min)

Explore the Aso Volcano Museum to learn about the geological wonders and history that shaped this dynamic landscape.



15:00

Visit Sugarukuzure Memorial Observatory (60 min)

Visit the significant "earthquake ruin" that commemorates the 2016 Kumamoto Earthquake. It marks the location of one of the disaster's most massive landslides and serves as a testament to the region's recovery and reconstruction.
