## Decadal Variability of Surface Meteorology Observed at some Research Stations in the Tibetan Plateau

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More than 10 years have passed since meteorological and hydrological observation started in 1998 as the Tibetan Project of GEWEX Asian Monsoon Experiment. Several surface stations have been deployed along the Xizan-Qinghai highway. During the succeeding observation program such as CAMP/Tibet and JEPP/Tibet, the stations are enhanced and even added, and the observation has been continued. Now, after the termination of JEPP/Tibet in 2008, the maintenance and data collections are dominantly continued by the effort of CAREERI/CAS. CAREERI has set up beautiful research station at the south-west of Naqu, conventionally called as BJ-SITE. Thus, it is the time to summarize the data obtained past twelve years together with the major research activities.

In this presentation the whole activity in past years are to be reviewed with appropriately compiled dataset. Discussion will be extended involving satellite data retrieval of surface parameters.
