

The Connection of Meteroids and Comets: Recent Progress

The meteoroids are generally believed to be ejected materials from comets. While the connection is no doubt, there are several meteor showers of which no parent comet has been identified. Recent observations reveal the possible relation of the asteroidal objects to the meteor showers. In this review, the recent progress of identifications will be introduced together with some notes on the formation of meteoroids within the parent bodies.
