

Distribution of Mars Express Scientific Data via the Planetary Science Archive

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The Planetary Science Archive (PSA) is an online archive facility supporting all of ESA's planetary missions.

Scientific and ancillary data from the Mars Express (MEX) mission will be distributed via the PSA, which is open to the worldwide scientific community, and should be the first port of call for all scientists looking for MEX data.

In the long run, the PSA will also be the repository for all of ESA's planetary missions such as Huygens, SMART-1, Rosetta and Venus Express.

This presentation gives an overview of the use and functionality of the PSA to show how data products and data sets should be queried, requested and retrieved from the archive.
