

BHUPENDRA NATH GOSWAMI

Prof. Bhupendra Nath Goswami was born on 1st August 1950, in Patbausi, Assam. With his Ph.D. from PRL, Ahmedabad, he did his Post Doctoral Research at MIT, Cambridge, USA with Prof. Jule Charney at NASA/GSFC, MD, USA. Returning to India, he worked at CAS/IIT, Delhi and CAOS, IISc., Bangalore since 1985. He was visiting Professor at University of Maryland and University of Princeton. Presently, he is the Director of Indian Institute of Tropical Meteorology, Pune, since 2006.

Prof. Goswami has mentored 5 Ph.D. and 5 M.Sc. (Engg) students and has 87 publications in referred journals of national and international repute. His publications highly cited.

He has received the Shanti Swarup Bhatnagar Award, 1995, Hari Om Ashram Prerit Vikram Sarabhai Award, 1994, The Kalpathi Ramakrishna Ramanathan Medal, 2008. He is a Fellow, Indian Academy of Sciences, Fellow National Academy of Sciences and Fellow, Indian National Science Academy and Member of several national and international commissions and committees.
