Yann Klinger got his PhD in geophysics in 1999 at University of Strabourg, France, where he worked on seismotectonics of the Dead Sea fault. From 1999 to 2001, he worked at the Seismolab of the Caltech, USA, as a postdoctoral fellow, focussing on paleoseismology in California and in Turkey. Since 2001, Y. Klinger is a permanent researcher at CNRS- Institut de Physique du Globe de Paris, where he focus on earthquake related issues at various time scales, along major faults both in Asia and in Middle-East. In 2008, Y. Klinger spent the year as an invited scholar at the Harvard University.
