Dr. Shailesh Nayak is the Secretary to the Government of India, Ministry of Earth Sciences (MoES) since August 2008. He has obtained PhD degree in Geology from the M.S University of Baroda in 1980. He was the Director, Indian National Centre for Ocean Information Services (INCOIS) since May 2006. He had set up the Tsunami Warning System for the Indian Ocean which is operational since October 2007.

Dr. Nayak had joined the Space Applications Centre in 1978 as a scientist and rose to become Group Director, Marine and Water Resources in 2001. He developed various algorithms and methodologies for application of remote sensing to coastal and marine environments.

He has been recipient of the National Mineral Award for the year 2005, and Indian National Remote Sensing Award for the year 1994. Currently, he is Chair, Indian Ocean — Global Ocean Observing System (IO-GOOS) and Vice-Chair, Intergovernmental Coordinating Group — Indian Ocean Tsunami Warning System (ICG-IOTWS).
