

NAOSHI HIRATA

Prof. Naoshi Hirata is full professor of Seismology continuously working in Earthquake Research Institute (ERI), the University of Tokyo from 1998. He is the former Director of ERI from April of 2009 to March of 2011. Now he serves as the Director of the Earthquake Prediction Research Center of ERI. He received PhD of Geophysics from the University of Tokyo in 1985. His research interests are observational seismology, crustal structure related to the generation mechanism of earthquakes, and earthquake prediction. He is now operating a special project for earthquake disaster mitigation in Tokyo Metropolitan area, in which 300 seismic stations in the area have been carefully deployed. For the public service, he is a member of Prediction Council for Areas under Intensified Measures Against Earthquake Disaster at the Meteorological Agency, Japan from 2005.
