Professor Robert Wasson is currently Visiting Professor at the Department of Geography, National University of Singapore, before which he was Deputy Vice-Chancellor of Research at Charles Darwin University since 2004. Key previous leadership roles have included Vice-Chair of the International Geosphere and Biosphere Program (IGBP) and Chair of the National Quaternary Committee of the Australian Academy of Science. His research interests focus on understanding the pathways by which water, sediment, nutrients, carbon and pollutants move through river catchments and to the coast; the role of land use and climate change in these movements; human responses to these movements; catchment management; extreme meteorological events in the Australian and Asian tropics.
