Professor Lou-Chuang Lee received a Ph.D. degree in physics from the California Institute of Technology in 1975. He specializes in space science and plasma physics. He was appointed as the Chief Scientist and later Director of National Space Organization in Taiwan from 1997 to 2004. He led the science and engineering teams implementing the FORMOSAT-2 and FORMOSAT-3 programs. Dr. Lee served as the President of National Central University from 2006 to 2008 and as the Minister of National Science Council from 2008 to 2012. Professor Lee is an Academician of Academia Sinica, TWAS Fellow, and IAA Member.
