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Professor K.S. Cheng has been with the Department of Bioenvironmental Systems Engineering, National Taiwan University since 1992. He teaches hydrology, remote sensing, statistics and stochastic hydrology. His research is in the area of stochastic hydrology focused on stochastic modeling and forecasting of hydrologic processes and uncertainties assessment of climate change impact on hydrologic extremes. Professor Cheng serves as the editor of *Terrestrial Atmospheric and Oceanic Sciences (TAO)* and *Paddy and Water Environment (PWE)*. He is a member of the Science Steering Committee of AsiaFlux. He has been invited to visit the Kyoto University, Japan; University of Southampton and University of Bristol, UK; and University of Florida, USA.
