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Dr. Bin Wang is Professor at the Department of Atmospheric Sciences at University of Hawaii at Manoa. He graduated from Ocean University of China and received his M.S. from Institute of Atmospheric Physics, CAS in 1981 and his Ph D. from Florida State University in 1984. Bin Wang has authored more than 290 peer-reviewed papers. His publications have been cited more than 20,000 times, with an h-index of 79 and 65 papers having more than 100 citations each (Google Scholar). Bin Wang was elected Fellow of American meteorological Society in 2009 and elected Fellow of American Geophysical Union in 2013. He received the Carl-Gustaf Rossby Research Medal in 2015 “for creative insights leading to important advances in the understanding of tropical and monsoonal processes and their predictability”.
