Dr. Danny Hilman Natawidjaja is a Senior Scientist in Indonesian Institute of Sciences and Leader of Earthquake Research Program. His M.Sc from University of Aucland, and Ph.D from California Institute of Technology (Caltech); focusses on neotectonics and earthquake studies. He and his colleagues develop the Sumatran cGPS Array (SuGAR) network since 2002; First collaborated with Caltech and now is jointly managed by LIPI and Earth Observatory of Singapore. He is the recipient of the Sarwono Prawirohardjo Award 2005, the highest recognition from the Indonesian Institute of Sciences for outstanding achievements in sciences and contributions in disseminating scientific knowledge to the benefits of public. He and his colleagues initiate the Graduate Research in Earthquake and Active Tectonics (GREAT) program at Institute of Technology Bandung in collaboration with the Australian Indonesian facility for Disaster Reduction and became a faculty member in the program. He was a chairman of the national team for developing the National Guide Lines for Natural Hazard and Risk Analysis, a UNDP program housed by the National Agency for Disaster Management (BNPB). He is also a core member of the national team for the Indonesian Probabilistic Seismic and Tsunami Hazard Assesments.
