Xianfeng Wang is a Nanyang Assistant Professor at the Earth Observatory of Singapore and Asian School of the Environment, Nanyang Technological University. He is a geochemist by training, and seeks to establish and understand the relationship between late Pleistocene and Holocene hydro-climate changes in the tropics and that of the other parts of the world. He also investigates the influence of tropical climate changes on human society, or if it is vice versa. To achieve this, Wang and his isotopic geochemistry team work with both terrestrial and marine sediment samples from the tropics, including speleothems and fossil corals. Wang completed his Post-Doctoral Fellowship at the Lamont-Doherty Earth Observatory of Columbia University, USA, after obtaining his PhD from the University of Minnesota.
