Stuart D. Bale is a Professor of Physics at the University of California, Berkeley. He is also the Director of the Space Sciences Laboratory at Berkeley. He has broad interests in space and solar physics, with particular expertise in instrument design and measurements. Bale is NASA Principal Investigator for instruments on the Wind and STEREO spacecraft and in development for the NASA Parker Solar Probe. He is a recipient of the US Presidential Early Career Award for Scientists and Engineers (PECASE) and is a Fellow of the American Physical Society (APS).
